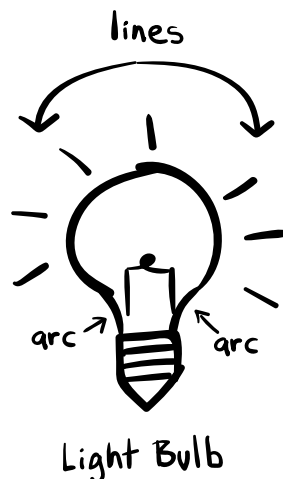
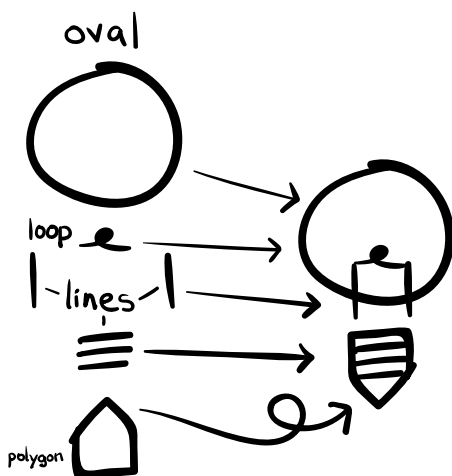
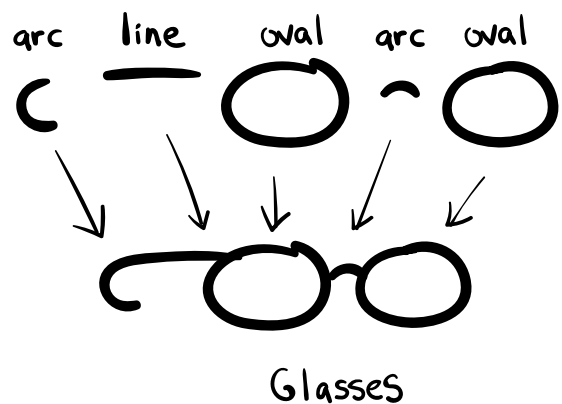
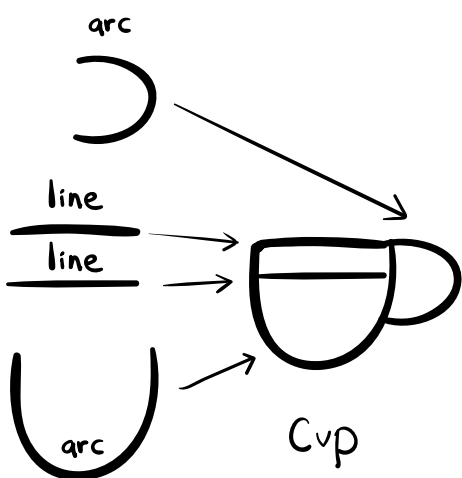
THE VISUAL ALPHABET
